

I. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Opening

Art.1

1. The Sports Centre is open all the year around, according to the schedule defined week after week. The schedule may be subject to change.
2. As needed, areas can be closed.
3. The price of the entrance gives you the right to use the concerning facilities of the Verbier Sports Centre, **the day that you buy the entrance. Anvexit is final!**
4. The Sports Centre is allowed to cancel any booking. In this case, no allowance should be paid, the reservation can be refund or replaced.
5. Any reservation can be cancelled **free of charge** no later than 24 hours in advance. For any cancellation **within 24 hours** prior the booking, the customer must pay the **100% of the amount due**.
6. The user gives the Verbier Sports Centre permission to publish, exhibit or broadcast the photograph or videos taken in the Verbier Sports Centre. This authorization is valid for any use (publications, website, social networks, etc.)

Security

Art. 2

The users adopt in all circumstances a reasonable behavior, prudent and respectful of his own safety and that of the other users.

Children

Art. 3

Minor children, even unaccompanied children, remain under the responsibility of their legal representatives.

Area of the center and surroundings/hygiene and cleanliness

Art. 4

1. Users agree to respect the premises and keep them clean.
2. Everyone is responsible for their waste. These must be thrown in the bins provided for this, including chewing gums
3. The keys will be handed over to the staff of the center or deposited in the ad hoc box immediately after the use of the spaces.

Equipment rental

Art. 5

The renter:

- is responsible for the rented equipment and takes care of it until surrender;
- report to the person responsible any damage to the equipment;

In case of abuse, the repair of the rented equipment will be the responsibility of the tenant.

Rules of conduct

Art. 6

Users of the Sports Centre:

- a. respect the surroundings and the neighborhood by avoiding noise and depredations;
- b. maintain courteous relations with each other and with the staff;
- c. use with care space and equipment.

Responsability

Art. 7

The Commune of Bagnes declines any responsibility towards the users, in particular concerning the thefts. It declines any responsibility for the damages suffered by the users of the sports center.

It also declines any responsibility in the event of an accident during a non-compliant use of the facilities and non-compliant with these regulations

Online sale

Art. 8

Upon presentation of an ID or subscription at the reception of the Sports Centre and after payment, you can access the reserved field. **If you are not there within 15 minutes after the start of your reservation, it will be transferred to the waiting customers.**

Ice rink

Art. 9

1. The public enter on the ice rink by the doors provided for this purpose.
2. The skater adapt their speed to the presence of the other users and to the technical capacities. They don't dare to walk, with the skates, only on the rubber tracks provided for this purpose.
3. It is strictly forbidden to the public :
 - a. to push the other skaters in any way;
 - b. to give or even to pretend to give loads against the railing, similar to body-checks;
 - c. to rush against the railing and against the other skaters by having the intention to stop at the last second ;
 - d. to try to lose the balance on another skater, even without touching it;
 - e. to throw objects on the ice rink or snowballs;
 - f. to use speed skates ;
 - g. to sit on the railings and on the material ;
 - h. to damage the ice rink;
 - i. to skate by carrying sound diffusers devices;
 - j. to skate by carrying other persons, little children included ;
 - k. to play hockey outside the moments and the spaces provided for this purpose.
 - l. excepted special authorisation, to enter with shoes on the ice rink;
 - m. to enter with prams on the ice rink;
 - n. to use the material for other purposes that they are provided.

Walkers

Art.10

Walkers are lent for free to **little children** to learn how to skate. The borrower :

- is responsible of the outstanding items and he takes care of it.
- report to the person in charge all the damages observed on the material.

Hockey

Art. 11

The ice hockey during the public skating is allowed on one ½ ice rink (valley side). The staff of the ice rink can, at every time, reduce the hockey surface or ask to stopping the game. In addition, the hockey players have to respect the following points to the letter:

- a) skaters have priority;
- b) pucks don't take off the ice rink;
- c) slapshots are forbidden ;
- d) no hockey during the curling.

II. PENAL CONDITIONS

Principles

Art.12

Anyone who doesn't observe the present regulations or doesn't follow up on the observations of the Sports Centre's staff will be subject to sanctions, without prejudice to more severe penalties that the offender may incur under the federal and cantonal legislation.

Decision authority

Art.13

All the staff of the sports center is able to take immediate action against those who violate this regulation.

Warning

Art.14

Faults of little seriousness will be sanctioned by an oral warning.

Expulsion

Art. 15

1. In serious cases, the Sports Centre's staff will expulse the offender.
2. The sports centre's subscription may be withdrawn and not refunded

Other measures

Art. 16

Following an expulsion, the Municipality of Bagnes will decide on a possible ban on attendance for a fixed period; if necessary, possibly also the restitution without delay of the pass.

Entrance fees

Art. 17

Those who don't pay the entrance fee may be reported to the Public Ministry. He will be liable to a fine, pursuant to art. 151 CPS.

Public force

Art.18

If an offender proves to be recalcitrant, the police may be called.

Right of appeal

Art.19

Any sanction taken by the Municipality of Bagnes can be the subject of a written appeal within 30 days.

III. FINAL CONDITION

Coming into force

Art. 20

This rules come into force immediately and these in French are authentic.
