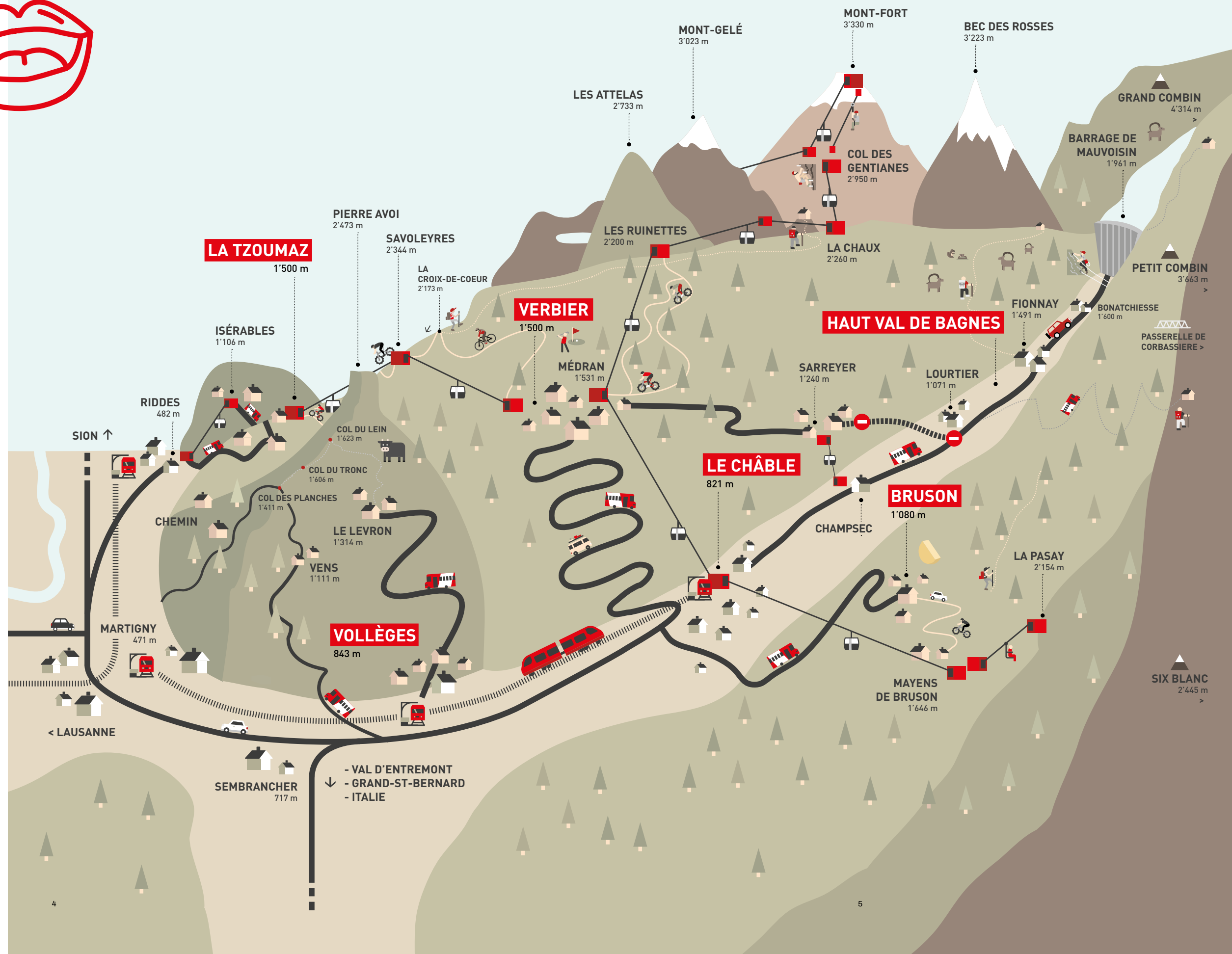
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# AN INFINITE PLAY- GROUND

The combined destination of Verbier — Val de Bagnes — La Tzoumaz is a vast playground, made up of **resorts** like **chic** Verbier, **family-orientated** La Tzoumaz, **villages** like Le Châble, Vollèges and Bruson, and also verdant **mountain pastures**, **high peaks** and **natural wild spaces**. 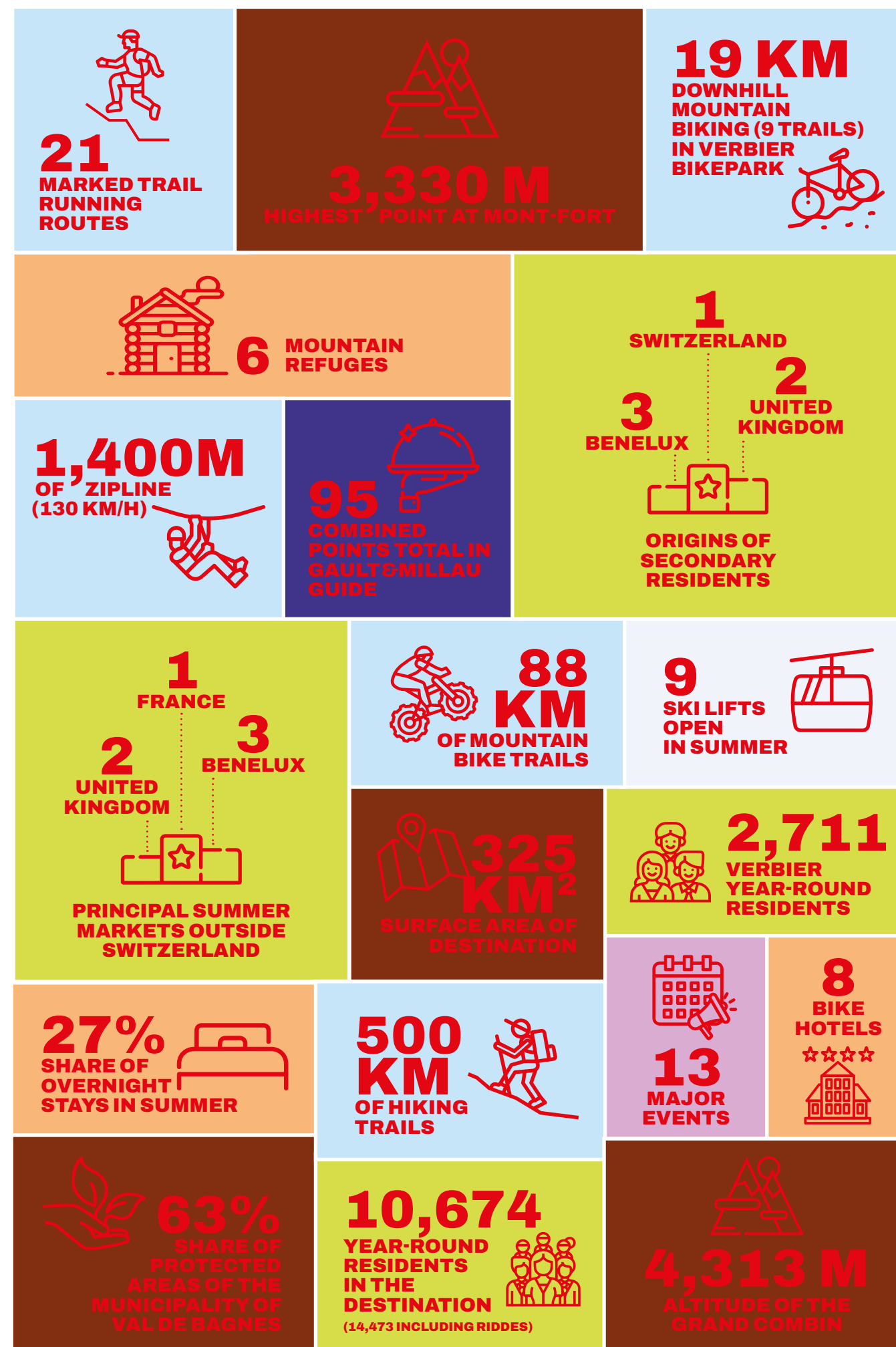
Due to its size and variety, Verbier is a **lively place to visit all year round**: there is always an event or activity going on! From June to September numerous events keep the heart of the region beating, from **music festivals** (electro, rock, classical and film music) to **sports events** for bikers, trail and obstacle course runners.

Whether looking to get away from the crowd, get some exercise or re-energise in the great outdoors, the visitor is spoilt for choice by the vast number of open spaces and endless places to explore from Verbier: with **over 700 km of bike trails** (MTB, e-bike, downhill, enduro and road) and **at least 500 km of hiking paths**, all well-maintained and signposted, it's easy to find inspiration to fill the day in Verbier.

## VIP PASS

For every night spent in the destination of Verbier – Val de Bagnes – La Tzoumaz, visitors receive a free VIP Pass. The Verbier Infinite Playground Pass (VIP Pass) offers discounts and privileged access to the entire area throughout the summer season. It is provided free of charge to all guests staying a minimum of one night in the region and paying the tourist tax. Exciting adventure experiences, outdoor and nature activities, local culture, family attractions... there's plenty for everyone to enjoy! Benefits offered by the VIP Pass include free pedestrian access to some ski lifts and a 50% reduction for cyclists, unlimited access to the municipality of Val de Bagnes bus services, preferential rates on a number of activities offered by destination partners, and a 50% discount on activities organised by Verbier, Le Châble and La Tzoumaz tourist offices.

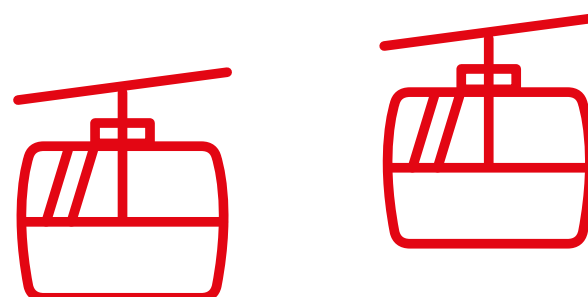


## VIP PASS TRAVEL OPTIONS

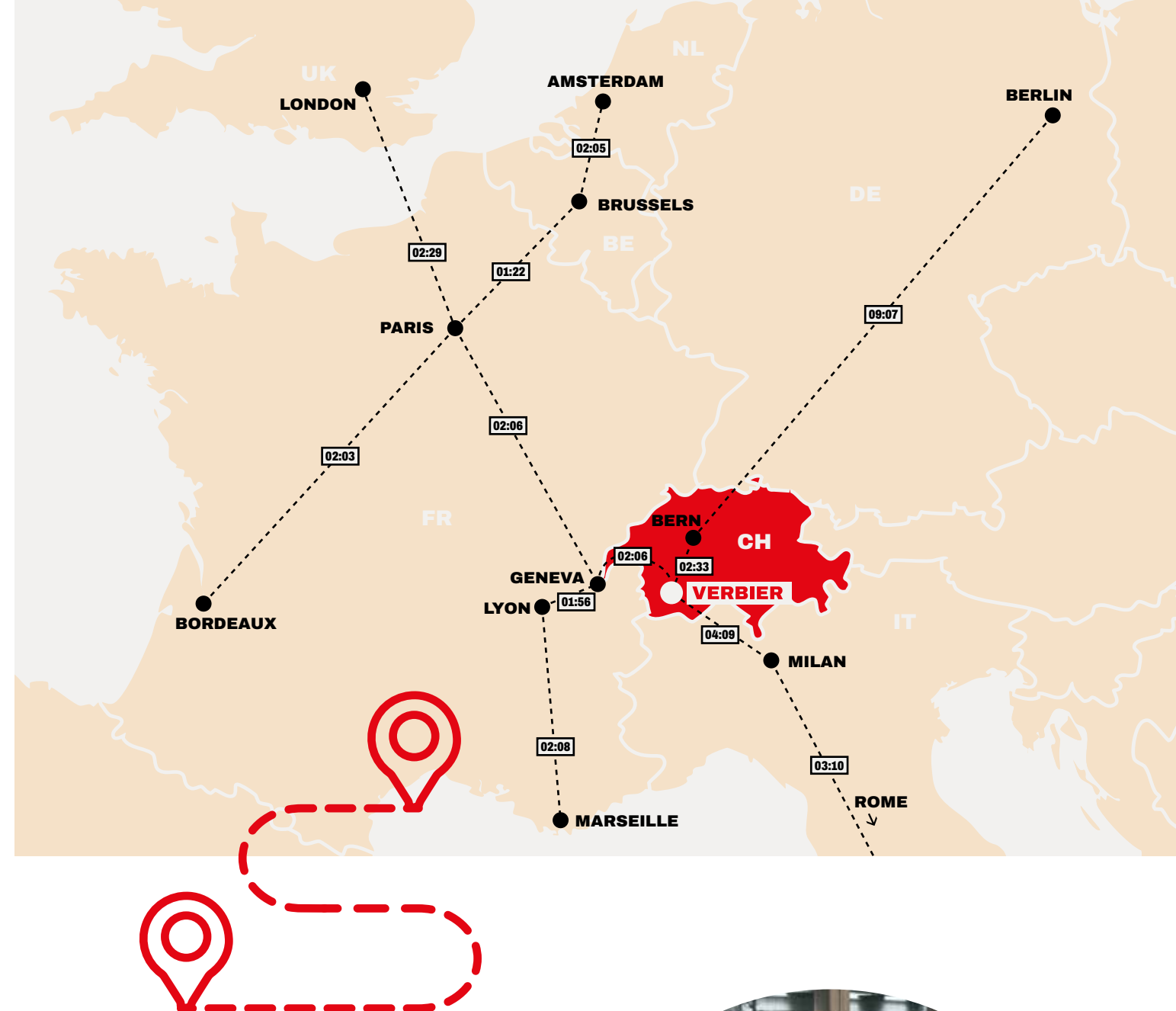
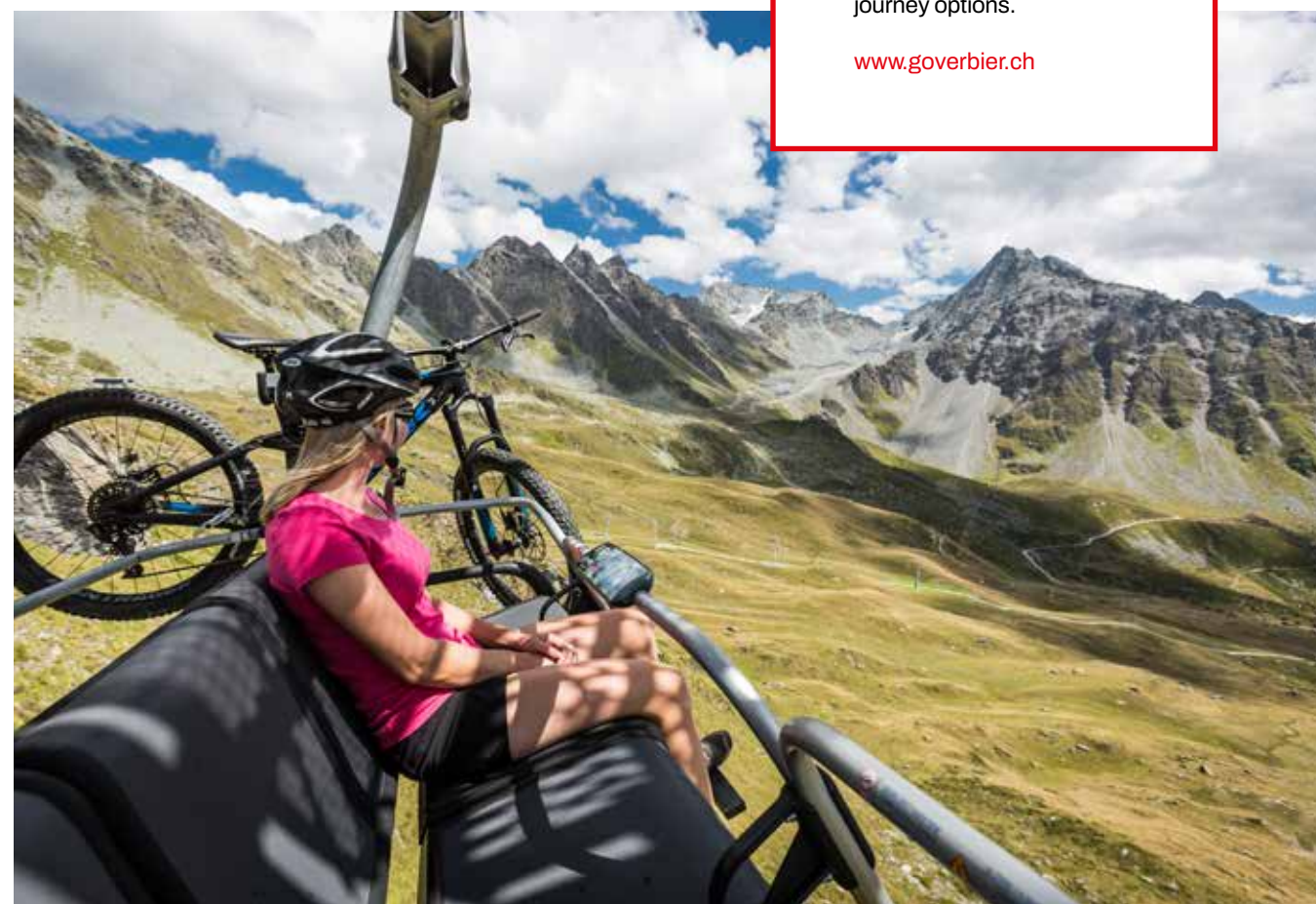

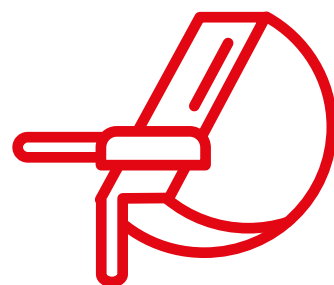
## EASY TO REACH BY TRAIN

## RACLETTE ≠ RACLONNETTE

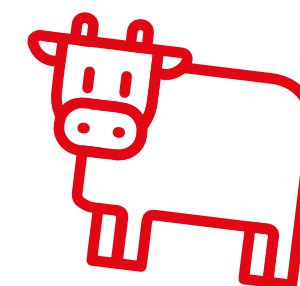

For raclette, someone grills and scrapes a half-wheel of cheese and serves their guests, whereas a raclonnette is prepared on small pans placed under a grill in the middle of the table.

## AGRITOURISM IN MONTAGNIER

Nestled in the village of Montagnier, Mauricette and Jean-Louis Fellay's venture is part of the Grand Entremont regional development project, supporting the creation of sustainable agritourism establishments. This new accommodation combines modern comforts with rusticity. Guests have the choice between two double rooms and a family room with bunkbeds, each with a private bathroom. Fresh produce from the farm is served daily at breakfast. Nearby, a smallholding with 30 goats offers educational visits and a shop sells local produce. Five minutes from the Le Châble cable car station and ten km from Verbier by road, this accommodation is an ideal base for both discovering the region and experiencing rural life.

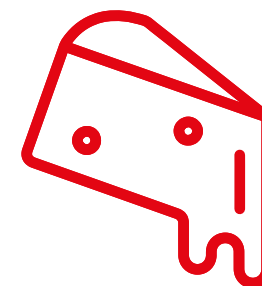
## THE GRAND ALPINE PRODUCE MARKET: → 14 - 15 JUNE

## ETIEZ'S BRAND-NEW CHEESE DAIRY

After several years of building works, organised so as not to disrupt cheese production, and especially that of Raclette AOP, the new Etiez cheese dairy was inaugurated in January 2025. The new dairy now groups together most of the Val de Bagnes producers in one location, ensuring quality cheese production for the foreseeable future. The new dairy is also part of a wider initiative, that of the Grand Entremont, which aims to support and boost mountain agriculture, in particular, by developing agritourism options. And so, in addition to the production facility, the public can visit a shop and café.

## CHEESE WORKSHOP: LEARN HOW TO MAKE A TOMME

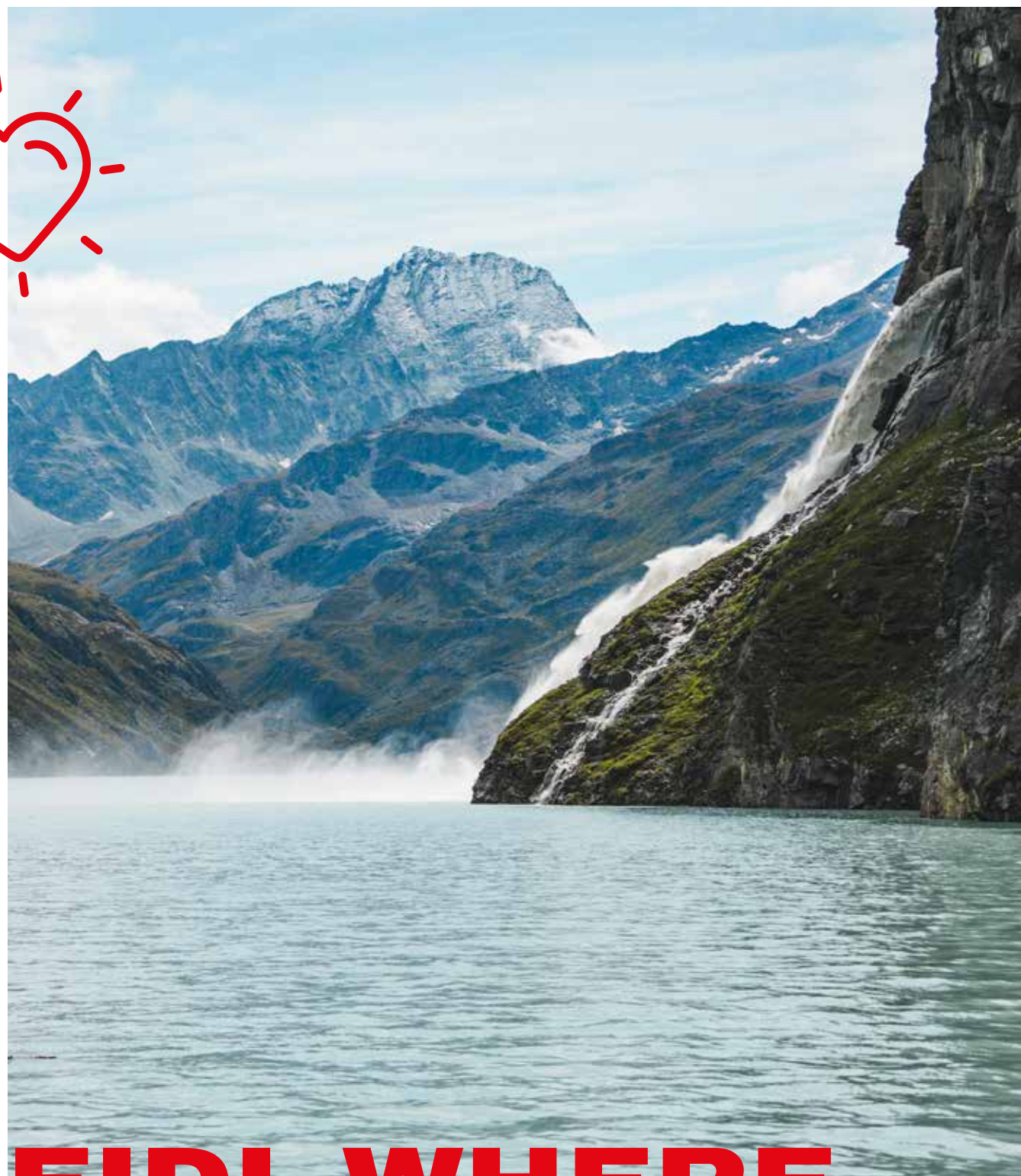
In the heart of Verbier-Village, passionate cheesemaker, Marc Dubosson, opens the doors of the Verbier Dairy for a unique and immersive experience. During this workshop, participants can learn the secrets of cheesemaking whilst crafting their own masterpieces. The history of cheesemaking, tales of the village and the family, shared throughout the workshop will give participants a real flavour of rich local heritage. The almost two-hour long session will share the secrets of Raclette AOP cheese of Valais, Val de Bagnes tomme and cheesemaking traditions specific to the region. At the end of the workshop, there will be an opportunity to savour the artisanal fruits of generations of know-how with a cheese-tasting. Participants can either leave with a fresh cheese or wait a few weeks to collect and taste their own matured, characterful tomme.

## < THE PROTECTED NATURAL AREA OF HAUT VAL DE BAGNES

Haut Val de Bagnes, with its rugged landscapes, vast glacial expanses, imposing mountain ranges and rich diversity of natural environments, is recognised as being of national importance. For this reason, it is listed in the IFP (Federal Inventory of Landscapes, Sites and Natural Monuments of National Importance) to protect its natural and unspoilt character. The region is also a federal conservation zone where the fauna is protected to allow the game to regenerate and maintain a healthy population.

## 100 YEARS OF THE CABANE MONT FORT

In 2025, the Cabane Mont Fort celebrates one century of Alpine history! Founded in 1925 by the Jaman section of the Swiss Alpine Club, it has become an iconic landmark and an important staging post in the Alps. To mark this centenary, several memorable events will be organised over the course of the year. In summer, three events will invite visitors into the world of mountain tales and legends and, from 1 June to the end of September, an exhibition along the Levron Bisse, from Ruinettes to La Chaux will explore the fascinating history of the Cabane Mont Fort. In July, in a moment of pure magic, the refuge will host a surprise concert, adding a musical touch to this jubilee. On 7 September, the Flying Frenchies collective will give an aerial performance combining extreme sports, artistic acrobatics and music from the Balkans. In December, a more reflective ceremony, with a mass given by the Canons Regular of the Hospitaller Congregation of Great St-Bernard, followed by a torchlight descent with a hundred mountain guides, will close the hundred-year celebrations. A year absolutely not to be missed, rich in emotion and memories and celebrating a century-long bond with the Alps!

## THE GUARDIAN ANGELS OF VAL DE BAGNES

A harmonious coexistence between humans and the natural world isn't something that can just be prescribed; it has to be acquired and sustained through direct contact with protected areas and their guardians. In Val de Bagnes, extensive natural zones, particularly in Haut Val de Bagnes, require protection. To prevent more environments being fragilised by over-frequen-tation, this summer, for the second consecutive year, a dedicated duo of rangers will patrol Haut Val de Bagnes to increase awareness of the need for a better coexistence with nature. They'll answer questions and offer directions aiming, by friendly intervention, to achieve a healthy balance between recreational activities, agriculture, tourism and protected natural areas.

## 2025 INTERNATIONAL YEAR OF GLACIERS' PRESERVATION

The glaciers of Giétro, Grand Combin, Corbassière, La Chaux, Tortin... Val de Bagnes is (still!) home to about one hundred ice giants. And the knowledge that glaciers flow and once covered a good part of Europe and all of Switzerland is, in part, due to a farmer from Lourtier called Jean-Pierre Perraudin who, at the beginning of the 19th century, in collaboration with engineer, Ignace Venetz,

contributed to the birth of glacier theory. These days, in Val de Bagnes, cradle of glacier studies, there are several ways to see these sentinels of climate change, either up close or from a distance. From Cabane Brunet, a hiking trail to the Cabane Panossière takes walkers across the Corbassière footbridge, suspended 70 metres above the glacier of the same name. Once installed at the Cabane

Panossière, hikers can drift into a restorative sleep to the cracking sounds of the glacier. An educational trail starting from the Col des Gentianes, at an altitude of more than 2,800 metres, informs hikers about glacier melt at various points along the route down to the Tortin glacier. For a more historical and scientific angle, visit the Maison des Glaciers, housed in the former Perraudin family home.







Summer in Verbier isn't just about pretty wooden chalets, cows grazing in the mountain pastures and flower-filled meadows stretching as far as the eye can see. Verbier challenges preconceptions and proves that the mountains have much more to offer.

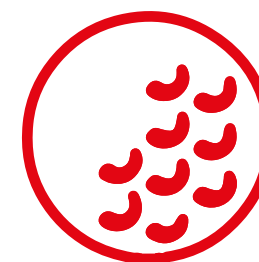


## VERBIER, 2 COURSES, 36 HOLES

With two 18-hole golf courses, Verbier rolls out the green carpet for fans of the little white ball from May to November! On Les Esserts course (par 69, 4,857 m long), known for its technicality, winding fairways and broad greens, golfers have the stunning backdrop of the Combins, Rognieux and Mont-Blanc massifs for inspiration. Designed to complement natural obstacles, numerous streams and the contours of the terrain, the course is a pleasant, gentle walk for golfers of all ages. More accessible, both in terms of its location in the centre of the resort and the difficulty level (18-hole, par 54, pitch and putt), the Moulins golf course is ideal for players of all levels wanting to work on their technique.

With a renowned bike park and more than 700 km of trails and mountain roads, Verbier is one of the main centres for mountain biking in Switzerland and a European benchmark. 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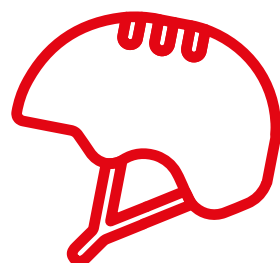
## TOWARDS ME, AWAY FROM ME

The inhabitants of Valais have developed certain expressions in their local dialect which reflect the reality of the topography of the Alps, expressions still used today in French to specify direction and altitude of movement in relation to the position of the speaker.

For example, "over there, same altitude as me" or even "coming from down there towards me, to up there away from me". If you speak French and hear the words "outré en-ça" or "en-là", expect to be completely disorientated!







## TOUR DES STATIONS → 20 - 23 AUGUST 2025

For its 8<sup>th</sup> edition, the Tour des Stations will take in 30 tourist destinations, with over 3,500 participants of 50 different nationalities expected. Regardless of the length and duration of their chosen route, it is the prospect of racing between exceptional resorts in a magnificent setting that motivates those taking part. One unique challenge in this bike race is that of attempting the elevation gain equivalent to Mount Everest in a single day! But participants can always opt to scale their 'own summit' from a choice of six different routes starting in Le Châble and finishing in Verbier.

## CABANE CHANRION - 2 DAYS OF E-BIKING

Biking is an ideal way to discover remote natural areas. From the foot of the Mauvoisin Dam, head to the top of this, the highest arch dam in Europe, for an interrupted view over Val de Bagnes. Take a few more pedal strokes to pass through the tunnels dug into the mountain before emerging into the light, above the majestic Lake Mauvoisin. At the end of the lake, one last climb awaits cyclists before reaching the mountain hut they are aiming for. Perched on a plateau at the intersection of several high valleys and surrounded by glaciers and mountain lakes, the Cabane Chanrion (2,462 m) offers unexpected comfort and has a charging point for e-bikes. After an overnight stay in the refuge, renovated in 2020, visitors can hike in the surrounding area or free-wheel back down to the valley.

## 2025 UCI MOUNTAIN BIKE WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS AND THE GRAND RAID

This year, Valais will be hosting the 2025 UCI Mountain Bike World Championships. This is the first time the entire championships will take place in the same region at the same time. The Grand Raid course departing from Verbier has been selected for the marathon. This means that the same route will be used by the best cyclists in the world at the same time as amateurs participating in the Grand Raid: a unique opportunity for those amateur racers to see how they measure up against the best during this legendary race in the MTB calendar!

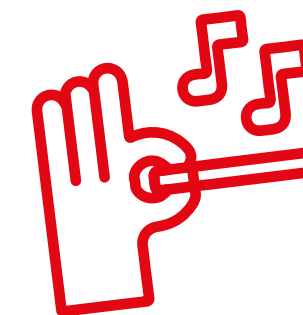

Consisting of a long tube of three to four metres in length (depending on the desired tone), with a wide upwards-curving bell at the base, the alphorn is traditionally carved from spruce wood. Once used to summon herds to their stables and to communicate, its slow melodies can resonate across the mountains for a distance of up to 15 km, depending on the weather conditions. Today, the alphorn is more than a simple instrument, it is a true national symbol.

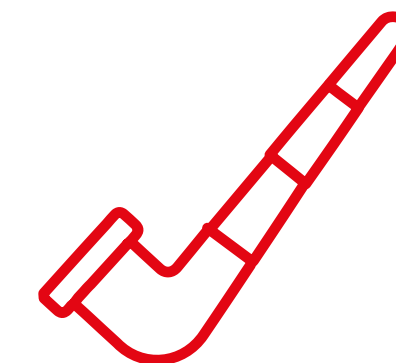

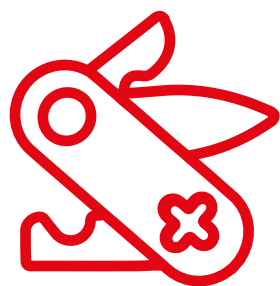
## FÊTE DES FAMILLES → 3 AUGUST 2025

The Gentianes via ferrata elevates thrill-seekers to heights over 2,800 m, with two different itineraries to choose from: one is about enjoying the views, the other presents a greater challenge interspersed with vertiginous sections. Higher still, at 3,330 m, the Mont-Fort via cordata combines hiking, climbing and a corded glacier traverse, an unforgettable 3hr 30min ascent followed by an easy return by gondola. The Mauvoisin Gorge offers a completely different setting, where a via ferrata suspended over the turbulent waters of the River Dranse offers two different levels of difficulty: 'Saxifrage' for a gentle initiation or 'Tichodrome' for a real challenge. Supervised by mountain guides, these experiences promise a combination of excitement, wonder and personal challenge.

Whether it's for lunch outside, a slice of tart at teatime or an overnight stay in the mountains, all reasons are good for stopping by this welcoming place.

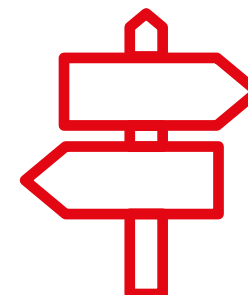

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## FOLIAGE COLOUR MAP

Autumn, with its glowing colours, transforms the Swiss forests and vineyards into natural works of art. Updated twice a week between September and November, with input from the official national weather service, it follows the transition of leaves from bright green through to scarlet. In addition, instant immersion into the autumn beauty of Val de Bagnes will be available via nine webcams installed above Verbier, La Tzoumaz and Bruson. From Paris, Brussels or London, one simple click will transport viewers into the heart of this ephemeral and magical spectacle.

## BELLOWING STAGS IN THE VALLON D'ARBI

At night, in the heart of the forest in the Vallon d'Arbi, a spine-chilling phenomenon can be heard: it is the sound of stags bellowing. In silence and total darkness, guides explain the distinctive characteristics of the stag, its habits and lifestyle and why it makes this particular roaring sound during the rutting season. With minimal disturbance to these naturally shy creatures, visitors can witness the spectacular scene taking place in this wild valley.

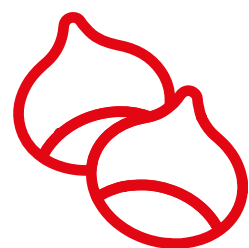




## BAGNES CAPITALE DE LA RACLETTE → 20-21 SEPTEMBER 2025

## GAME DISHES AND LOCAL PRODUCE

In Val de Bagnes, the game season is eagerly awaited, when the natural bounty of the region lands on a plate. Traditional and tasty game dishes illustrate the character and quality of the local 'terroir'. Typical regional dishes such as venison stew, venison tenderloin and wild boar ragout are often accompanied by spätzle, lingonberry jam, caramelised chestnuts and poached pears. Each mouthful is a taste of nature and an authentic culinary experience deeply rooted in local tradition. One of the top addresses in the region, famous for its game menus, is La Promenade restaurant at Bonatchiesse, in the depths of Haut Val de Bagnes. In this well-renowned establishment, diners are invited to sample a five-course feast full of local flavour, with each dish more delicious than the last.

## IN THE STEPS OF A FORESTER

Nature lovers are invited to join a forester and unravel the mysteries of local fauna and flora during a fascinating ramble. Observing animal tracks, calculating the age of trees, learning about the mechanisms that preserve this unique ecosystem: many enlightening experiences will be shared in the open air.

Guided by enthusiasts, participants will get to see the forest around Verbier from a different angle, combining observation, transmission of knowledge and fascination. This is an invitation to slow down, listen, feel and discover the wealth of this living environment.



## WINE BARS AND LOCAL WINES

With demand exceeding production and prohibitive exportation costs, Swiss wines are little known abroad. And yet, a long tradition and multiple specialities have resulted in high quality vineyards: a source of pride for the Swiss. While most restaurants have local wines on the menu, a few highly rated establishments are worth a closer look. In respect of wine producers, the village of Riddes, below La Tzoumaz, is home to several cellars where visits and tastings are available. For wine tastings, 67 Pall Mall Verbier offers the biggest wine selection in Switzerland to its members and a selection from the cellar is available in the wine bar open to the general public.
